

## SIGNALS and COARSES

### The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 – 2016 USSA

- **STARTING SHAPE:** WARNING – WHITE; PREPARATORY – BLUE; START – RED. The START signal for the next race.
- **COURSE SIGNALS:** when COLORED BOARDS ARE DISPLAYED beside the course letters, shall be left to PORT and the GREEN Board shall indicate a STARBOARD rounding
- **POSTPONEMENT:** Code and Answering Pennant (Red and White Vertical Bars) and TWO GUNS. One gun will be fired when the Postponement Signal is lowered. The next signal will be for the following class and will be one minute after the Postponement Signal is lowered.
- **COURSE CHANGE:** Code Signal “E” (Red and Blue horizontal Bars) will be shown and a new course for classes not yet started. After starting, a course change will be signified by code and the posting of the modified course. Attention to this change shall be done by repeating the signal and the posting of the modified course.
- **INDIVIDUAL RECALL:** Code signal :X: (White with blue Cross). ONE ADDITIONAL GUN will be fired if more yachts have started prematurely. The Race Committee will attempt to hail the yacht that has incorrectly rests with the yacht concerned.
- **GENERAL RECALL:** FIRST REPEATER (Yellow and Blue) TWO ADDITIONAL GUNES will be fired. A Black circle) will indicate one minute rule will apply. One sound signal will be made with the PREPARATORY Signal will follow one minute after the lowering of the FIRST REPEATER.
- **ABANDONMENT:** Code Signal “N” (Blue and White Checkerboard) Over Code signal “H”. All races for the day are cancelled for the day. Three guns will call attention to this signal.
- **TWICE AROUND:** A RED SIGNAL BOARD displayed above the course letters/numbers in the course. AROUND. MARK X will be honored only when posted.
- **FOLLOW ME:** Code Signal “L” (Yellow and Black Squares) When the signal is made, the fleet should follow. TWO GUNS will call attention to this signal.
- **SHORTEN COURSE:** Code signal “S” (White field-blue square) plus TOW AUDIBLE SIGNAL.
- **CODE SIGNAL “Y”** (Yellow and Red Diagonal Bars) and THREE HORN BLASTS. Wear appropriate
